

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 109078 IN THE CITY OF CARLISLE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to riverbank erosion and to enable repair works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along an approx. 53 metre section of Public Footpath No.109078 at the Sheepmount in the City of Carlisle extending between Grid References: 339463 556724 and 339420 556686.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians on public highways. However, the landowner will provide an informal diversion around the sports pavilion which will be signed on the ground.

This follows an emergency notice dated 5 June 2024.

The Order will come into operation on 26 June 2024 and may continue in force for a period of up to six months from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. It is anticipated that it will be required for 6 months.
