

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 244050 IN THE PARISH OF MARYPORT)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Order made by Cumberland Council on 30 January 2024, which became operative on 5 February 2024, to enable restoration works to be carried out (“the Works”) and which would otherwise expire on 5 August 2024  
**:has been continued in force with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport until 31 December 2024.**

The effect of the Order is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along that section of Public Footpath No. 244050 Eel Sike in the Parish of Maryport from its junction with Public Footpath No. 244059 at grid reference 303448 534864, extending in a south westerly direction for approx. 433 metres to grid reference 303168 534544.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians.

If the works have not been completed within the extension period, the Order may be extended for a further period with the approval of the appropriate Minister.
