

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (FOOTPATH NO. 431017 IN THE PARISH OF WHITEHAVEN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Network Rail to carry out bridge examination and vegetation works (“the Works”), Cumberland Council has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit pedestrians from proceeding along an approx. 40 metre section of Public Footpath No. 431017 off Uldale Road, Whitehaven, either side of the railway bridge, between Grid References: 297991, 516362 and 297935, 516352.

There is no suitable alternative route available for pedestrians.

The Order will come into operation on 1 July 2024 and may continue in force for a period of up to six months from that date as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed, although it is anticipated that it will only be required for 1 day.
