Commons Act 2006 - Section 19(2)(d) NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE REGISTER

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **David Alejandro Rivera ("the Applicant")** to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(d) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to register unit CL59 Netherwasdale Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 724.4 sheep and their lambs (or equivalents), the right to wash sheep, the rights of turbary and estovers, and the right to take pinnel and stone for use in connection with the holding on Netherwasdale Common ("the Right") is currently registered as attached to land at Windsor Farm at entry 40 of register unit CL59 in the names of David S Gill and Freida Rivera-Schreiber. The Applicant changed his name, by way of a deed dated 6th February 2019, to David Alejandro Rivera and by this application he seeks to record his new name in the register.

If the application is granted, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by amending the register to show the Right in the names of David A Rivera and Freida Rivera-Schreiber.

Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.
