## Commons Act 2006 - Section 19(2)(c) NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE REGISTER

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **T. H. Cartmell** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(c) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL20 Caldbeck Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 300 sheep, 15 cattle or equivalent in sheep, the right to take stone and rights of turbary on Caldbeck Fell comprising the whole of the land in the register unit ("Right 1") is registered at entry 40 of register unit CL20 as attached to O.S. fields numbered 302, 303, 304, 310, 349, 350, 351, 352, 353, 386, 389, 390, 392, 394, 395, 396, 441 and 356.

A right of common to graze 164 units on Caldbeck Common comprising the whole of the land in this register unit is registered at entry 60 of the same register unit ("Right 2") as attached to O.S. fields numbered 387, 388, 354, 356, 355, 384, 382, 383, 385, 399 and 459.

Both entries show rights attached to the whole of O.S. 356. The Applicant claims that this is a duplicate entry in the same way as if all the land described in column 5 for both entries had been the same. The Applicant requests that both entries be amended to remove "356" and substitute "part 356".

If the application is granted, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by deleting entries 40 and 60 and making two new entries showing Right 1 as attached to O.S. fields numbered 302, 303, 304, 310, 349, 350, 351, 352, 353, 386, 389, 390, 392, 394, 395, 396, 441 and part 356 and Right 2 as attached to O.S. fields numbered 387, 388, 354, part 356, 355, 384, 382, 383, 385, 399 and 459.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must guote the Application No. CA10/46
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The date on which the period for making representations expires is 5pm on 10th February 2020.
