Application for apportionment of rights of common

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Application Number: CA3/40

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority ("the CRA"), has considered an application submitted by **Raymond Jonathan Ridley and Susan Vivienne Ridley** ("the Applicants") seeking to apportion the right of common attaching to O.S. field numbers 106 and 131 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) of the parish of Long Marton, Westmorland, recorded at entry number 16 of CL80 Knock Fell and entry 43 of CL82 part of Dufton Fell called 'the disputed area' ("the Right") and to register the apportionment in the register of common land.

**Decision**

The CRA resolved to accept the application to amend the register by registering the apportionment of the Right.


**Reasons**

The Commons Registration Officer assessed the application and found it to be duly made under the criteria prescribed by the relevant regulations and guidance.

**Outcome**

The rights sections of the registers for CL80 Knock Fell and CL82 part of Dufton Fell 'the disputed area' have been amended to show the Right as apportioned in accordance with the Notice of Application as attached to this decision.

**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPORTIONMENT OF RIGHTS OF COMMON**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Raymond Jonathan Ridley and Susan Vivienne Ridley** ("The Applicants") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 8 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014. The application relates to entry number 16 of the common land register unit CL80 Knock Fell and entry number 43 of the common land register unit CL82 part of Dufton Fell called 'the disputed area'.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The following right is attached to O.S. field numbers 106 and 131 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) of the Parish of Long Marton, Westmorland, and is exercisable over the whole of the land in register units CL80 Knock Fell and CL82 part of Dufton Fell called 'the disputed area'.

"The right to graze a) 3 ewes with their followers and b) 2 hogs together with the right of turbary over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit CL80 together with the whole of the land comprised in register unit CL82" ("The Right").

Pursuant to the division of the land to which the Right is attached, the Applicants seek by their application to register apportionment of the Right appropriate to the parts of land transferred and now in their ownership.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by making the following amendment to the commons register:

1. Entry numbers 16 and 43 will be deleted and reference made to the new corresponding entries.
2. Addition of supplemental maps.
3. The following entries will be made to the rights section of the commons registers CL80 and CL82 to show the proportionate apportionment of the Right to the applicants (a) Raymond Jonathan Ridley and Susan Vivienne Ridley, and (b) Stephen Barry Charlton and Jan Allison.

a. The right to graze a) 2.43 ewes and followers and b) 1.62 hogs together with the right of turbary over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit CL80 together with the whole of the land comprised in register unit CL82. The right is attached to O.S. field numbers pt. 106 and 131 as shown coloured red on the proposed supplemental map.

b. The right to graze a) 0.57 ewes and followers and b) 0.38 hogs together with the right of turbary over the whole of the land comprised in register unit CL80 together with the whole of the land comprised in register unit CL82 is attached to O.S field number pt. 106 as shown coloured blue on the proposed supplemental map.


Any person wishing to make representations:

- must state the grounds on which they are made and must be signed by the person making them;

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the authority to disclose information received from you to others, which will include the Applicants and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on **17 January 2022**.
