

Commons Act 2006 – Section 13

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO REMOVE A RIGHT OF COMMON FROM THE REGISTER

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Anne Fisher and David Frank Wearing** (“the Applicants”) to Westmorland and Furness Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 13 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL206 Ease Meadow.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows:

The right to the herbage every alternate year and the right to graze 10 head of cattle over the whole of the land in this register unit (“the Right”) is registered at entry 4 of the rights section of register unit CL206 as attached to Far Houses Farm comprising O.S. nos. 318, 297, 298, 295, 292, 293, 294, 299, 271, 275, 300, 302, 304, 303, 305, 306, 319, and 291 on the O.S. map (edition of 1913) of the parish of Kirkby Ireleth.

The Applicants claim that the Right was surrendered by way of a Deed dated 31st March 2023. The surrender does not operate at law until the Right has been removed from the register. The Applicants seek by this application to complete the surrender and remove the Right from register unit CL206 Ease Meadow.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting entry 4 (making reference to the new corresponding entry) and making a new entry in the register to show the Right as extinguished.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA7/3**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and


Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on **14th November 2023**.
