APPLICATION TO REGISTER LAND AS A TOWN OR VILLAGE GREEN

Notice of Determination

Notice is hereby given that Westmorland and Furness Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has considered an application submitted by Mr Ian McIntyre, Mr James David Griffiths and Mr Stephen Neil Silver (“the Applicants”), to register land at the junction of Empress Drive and Mikasa Street, South Walney, Barrow in Furness, known as The Celtic (“the Application Land”), and shown outlined in red on the attached plan, as a town or village green.

Decision

The CRA resolved to accept the application, and register the Application Land as a new village green.


Reasons

The Commons Registration Officer assessed the application and found it to be duly made under the criteria prescribed by the relevant regulations and guidance. No objections were received against the application, and all of the statutory criteria to register the Application Land as a town or village green in accordance with section 15 (8) of the Commons Act 2006 (voluntary registration by owner) have been satisfied.

Outcome

The Application Land will be registered as a new village green which will entail the addition of a new register entry confirming registration of the Application Land and amendment of the register map showing the Application Land marked as a registered village green.


