

**Commons Act 2006 - Section 15(2)**

**Application to register land at Croft Terrace, Penrith as a town or village green**

**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

**Application Number: NL0065**

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority, has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee ("the Committee") on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2018, considered an application to register land at Croft Terrace, Penrith as a new town or village green.

**Decision**

The Committee resolved to refuse the application, and not add the Application Land to the register of town and village greens.

**Reasons**

The Committee took into account a report by Commons Officer ("the Officer"). The Officer's report recommended that the Committee refuse the application, on the basis that the statutory criteria to register the Application Land as a town or village green, in accordance with section 15 (2) of the Commons Act 2006 had not been satisfied.

**Outcome**


The Application Land will not be registered as a village green and the register and legal maps will remain unaltered.
