

Deep and meaningful? The religious education subject report (April 2024): The Ofsted subject report evaluates the common strengths and weaknesses of religious education (RE) in the schools visited. It shares what Ofsted has learned and builds on the Ofsted religious education research review which identified factors that can contribute to high-quality school religious education curriculums, the teaching of the curriculum, assessment and systems.
