We will ensure that we fully promote all four licensing objectives through the steps we have outlined below for each licensing objective that we intend to take. Furthermore these steps will be monitored and reviewed regularly to ensure the effectiveness of the steps and where necessary we will implement appropriate changes for improvement

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

We will take the following steps to promote the above licencing objective (a) ensure that all staff understand the social responsibilities associated with the sale and supply of alcohol (b) measures to prevent customers leaving licensed premises with bottles or glasses (c) entry and exit policies including proof of age, responsible management/non admission to persons who are drunk and/or disorderly (d) appropriate levels of exterior lighting to discourage disorder whilst minimising the impact on neighbouring properties (e) effective management of the premises including written procedures for managing incidents (f) keeping an incident book for any incidents and actions taken by staff, (g) cooperating with the Police when requested (h) using challenge 25 and verifying ID with acceptable forms of ID to include a passport, driver's license, or a PASS card

c) Public safety

We will take the following steps to promote the above licencing objective (a) ensure that the premises both internally and externally are maintained in good, clean and tidy conditions at all times (b) ensure there is clear signage in and around the premises (c) maintain at all times safe capacity levels within the premises (d) regular maintenance and testing of safety systems (e) carry out a risk assessment of the property annually (f) staff training on food hygiene, cross contamination, allergies (g) conduct regular toilet checks (h) ensure first aid equipment and materials are available on the premises

d) The prevention of public nuisance

We will take the following steps to promote the above licencing objective (a) Keeping doors and windows closed where possible (b)being mindful of the location of the premises (c) we have considered public nuisance when establishing the design of the premises by soundproofing the ceiling and double glazing the window (d) managing arrangements for collections and disposal of wates and empty bottles (e) attempt to prevent customers congregating outside the premises in groups (f) complying with the conditions of the premises licence

e) The protection of children from harm

We will ensure that we will take the following steps to promote the above licencing objective (a) strictly enforcing Challenge 25 and verifying ID with acceptable forms of ID to include passport, driver's licence or pass card (b) training staff to recognise fake ID (c) ensuring comprehensive and up to date staff training (c) requiring children to be accompanied by an adult (d) ensuring children and young people are not exposed to strong language or any violent disorder (e) provide highchair facilities for the use by young children (f) ensure that accompanying adults are able to take responsibility for and supervise the children at all times (g) provide adequate clean and safe baby changing facilities (h) ensure that staff are fully aware of any restrictions to children and young persons access and supervision requirements
