### **NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONVERT FOOTWAYS TO SEGREGATED FOOTWAY AND CYCLETRACK – ENGLISH STREET, THE CRESCENT, BOTCHERGATE AND COURT SQUARE BROW JUNCTION, CARLISLE**

1. Cumberland Council hereby give notice that it is proposing to widen the existing footways and convert parts to segregated cycle tracks, using its powers under Section 66(4) and Section 65(1) of the Highways Act 1980.
2. The proposed cycle tracks, approximately 95m in length, in total, will be located at the junctions of English Street, The Crescent, Botchergate and Court Square Brow, Carlisle, to form a one-way cycling loop. A further 25m of bi-directional segregated cycle track is proposed to run up the north-eastern kerb line of English Street to connect to the existing bi-directional segregated cycleway.
3. The segregated cycle tracks will be approximately 1.5m (minimum) metres in width in one-way areas, and 2.5m (minimum) in bi-directional areas.
