

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (BOTCHERGATE, CARLISLE)  
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2008

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 1 September 2008 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Botchergate, Carlisle) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2008
2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 to this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the following lengths of road between the hours of 9 pm and 5 am the following day on a Friday and Saturday each week: -
  - (1) Botchergate, Carlisle, from its junction with The Crescent, extending in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 240m to its junction with Tait Street;
  - (2) Mary Street, Carlisle, from its junction with Botchergate for a distance of 41m in an easterly direction; and
  - (3) Portland Place, Carlisle, from its junction with Botchergate for a distance of 55m in an easterly direction.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply to vehicles which are being used for Police, Fire or Ambulance purposes.
4. Article 33, Schedule XXXIII of The County of Cumbria (Various Roads, Carlisle Urban and Rural Area) (Consolidation and Minor Amendment of Traffic Regulations) Order 2001 is hereby revoked only insofar as it relates the exemption for loading and unloading to the prohibition of entry to Mary Street, Carlisle, from its junction with Bartons Place and only during the times and on the days specified in Article 2 hereto.
5. The County of Cumbria (Currock Road, Carlisle) (Experimental Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2008 is hereby revoked.
6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
