

THE COUNTY OF CUMBRIA (BOTCHERGATE, CARLISLE)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) (ORDER 2008) VARIATION ORDER (NO.1) 2009

The County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (4) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 19 January 2009 and may be cited as The County of Cumbria (Botchergate, Carlisle) (Prohibition of Driving) (Order 2008) Variation Order (No. 1) 2009
2. For the purposes of this Order the expression "the 2008 Order" shall mean The County of Cumbria (Botchergate, Carlisle) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2008
3. The 2008 Order shall have effect as though Article 2 was amended to read as follows :-
 2. Save as provided in Articles 3 and 4 to this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the following lengths of road between the hours of 9 pm on a Friday, Saturday and the day immediately prior to each Bank/Public Holiday, and 5 am the following morning: -
 - (1) Botchergate, Carlisle, from its junction with The Crescent, extending in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 240m to its junction with Tait Street;
 - (2) Mary Street, Carlisle, from its junction with Botchergate for a distance of 41m in an easterly direction; and
 - (3) Portland Place, Carlisle, from its junction with Botchergate for a distance of 55m in an easterly direction.
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
