- (ii) Proposal 2 , U2219, Portinscale, at a point at its junction with C2057, proposal to Introduce "No Waiting At Any Time" (double yellow lines) (a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, and, (c) for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians)
