1. Welcome and introductions

Apologies for absence and substitutions – as above. The meeting wasn't quorate. Members introduced themselves. From JY's update members were asked 'Should the subject of RE be part of a new National Curriculum?' An interesting discussion took place with a variety of opinions being shared to help inform and develop an understanding of the issues involved.

2. Minutes of previous meeting held on 9 October 2024 – an amendment was made to the role of Sally Elton-Chalcraft who works with primary teachers, not secondary. The minutes were agreed.

3. Matters arising not covered in the agenda –

- Councillor CS asked if there was a vacancy for a Roman Catholic rep at present Bernadette Little is on committee C, Teacher Associations but she is also from a catholic school.
- SACRE Annual report – this has been delayed as we are waiting for data on A level and GCSE results, the delay is down to the DfE. This data hasn't been in our reports over the last few years. Once the data is received the report will be ready to go.

4. Feedback from working group

- Development Plan – it was agreed that the points in our Development Plan should be evaluated after each meeting.
- A meeting took place with Deborah Weston, NATRE Research Officer and JY, RL and DH regarding provisional data received from schools via the school workforce census. Some schools are not responding. We need to get correspondence out about the importance of accurate input, ask Senior Manager to help. The results are in the process of being validated. A Level results still outstanding for Cumberland.
- CR has been looking at the information on school websites, 37 schools have been reviewed. The findings were re-assuring for KS3. RE is often covered under other subjects such as PHSE and Personal Development. CR will write up a report and circulate to members. DH highlighted evidence that children who are taught RE and worldviews do better in their education. CR thanked for all the work she has done on this.
- Community Cohesion – JY and KO'D are now attending a lot more events to talk about SACRE. The newsletter is also being sent to other organisations that we are linking with. Members were asked if anyone else was interested in attending future events to promote SACRE.
- JY is working with Colne Park Primary in Lancashire as part of her RE Hubs role. The school has embedded community cohesion in their RE and equalities work. Can our schools learn from this? JY to circulate presentation slides about the school.
- Look at updating our Visits and Visitors guidance for schools.
