Introduction to Personal Travel Budgets (PTBs)

A PTB is a sum of money allocated to parents/carers to enable them to get their child to school. It offers families choice and flexibility, and how the money is spent is completely at the families' discretion.

"I like the freedom of spending my budget on the transport that I need. Some days my child uses the bus, other days I book my own taxi."

Some families would prefer to take their own child to school but can't afford to

Some children find Council provided transport too long, stressful and tiring

Some children like to attend after school clubs and activities which they can't, due to the transport leaving at the end of the school day

Personal Travel Budgets in Cumberland



Payments are calculated on an individual basis taking into consideration the child's needs as well as the current potential cost to the Council of transporting the child to school. This means each PTB will be tailored individually to each child.

The Council pays £0.45 for each mile of the journey to and from school, plus an extra daily amount between £5 an £45 if your family needs it.

You might get extra money if your child:

- has medical needs that require quick attention
- needs extra support to travel safely
- needs an adult to travel with them
- lives in a rural area or has a long journey

Using a Personal Travel Budget

You can spend the PTB how ever you like, as long as your child travels in a way that ensures their safety, ensures their attendance and enables them to arrive at school on time and in a positive manner ready to learn.



Personal Travel Budgets in Cumberland



Payments will be made to the parent/carer who will agree to be responsible for their child's travel and attendance at their school/educational establishment







Personal Travel Budgets should not affect any other benefits that you may receive. However, it is best to check with your benefit provider



Regular agreed amounts will be paid into a nominated bank account



If a child's attendance drops below an agreed level or they persistently do not arrive at school on time, then the PTB may be at risk of being reduced, suspended or stopped
