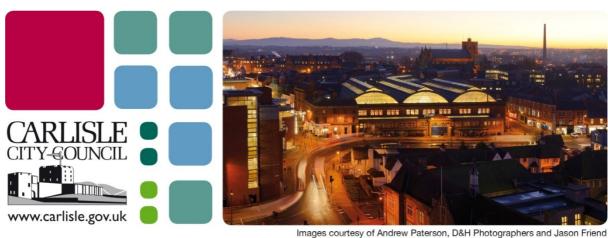

I write on behalf of my clients in support of the allocation of site reference R5 – Land South of Old Road, Longtown.

My clients confirm that the land (R5) is available to be developed and that they support the allocation of the site for housing in the Site Allocation and Policies Plan document.

It is my client's view that the development of the land for residential purposes is acceptable for the following reasons:

- The allocation of the land complies with the policy objectives contained within the Carlisle District Local Plan Proposed Submission Draft (PSD) February 2015;
 Longtown is identified as a District Centre in the PSD. Figure 4.20 of the PSD
- (Policy EC5 District and Local Centres) identifies that the area has sufficient services in order to support the proposed allocations.
