Please be as precise as possible: The Council agree that 800m is an improvement on the original separation distance but in order to protect all individuals we consider that this should be extended to 1000m. The Neurological Department of Aston University consider that "the EN 3 assumption that shadow flicker does not occur more than 10 x rotor diameter is flawed" and it is their view that "that the 10 X rotor diameter recommendation should be increased in the light of emerging science". A planning application for a turbine in this parish was submitted last year with a separation distance of 900m from the home of a young girl who suffered from epilepsy. Had the application been successful it could well have had a detrimental effect on the health of this young person. Q6.
