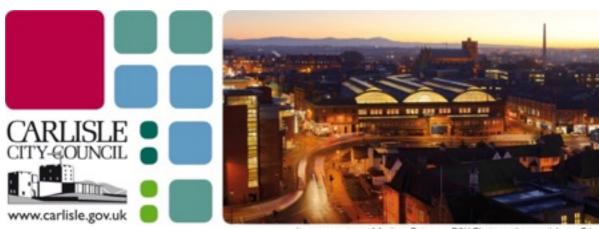

Further land is considered to be appropriate to be included into the Plan for housing which will enable a suite of sites to come forward pending issues over the confidence of the Plan to deliver a strategic site such as South Carlisle within the Plan Period and offer a greater variety of sites to encourage a mix of site type and areas in order to encourage a variety of site types and locations as not everyone looking for a new house will be looking for the same location or a major development. An appropriate level of smaller sites with access to high levels of existing services would enable a responsive and fast moving housing market to emerge throughout the City.

In respect of this, a site is available with access from Beaumont Road already in place, and agreement from the Highway Authority that the land can be adequately accessed. The land has in recent years been partly reclassified as Flood Zone 3 however, discussions to date have indicated that a technical solution to this can be found.

The development of this site would be in accordance with policy which seeks to:

- deliver a wide choice of quality homes; and
- create sustainable, inclusive, mixed communities.

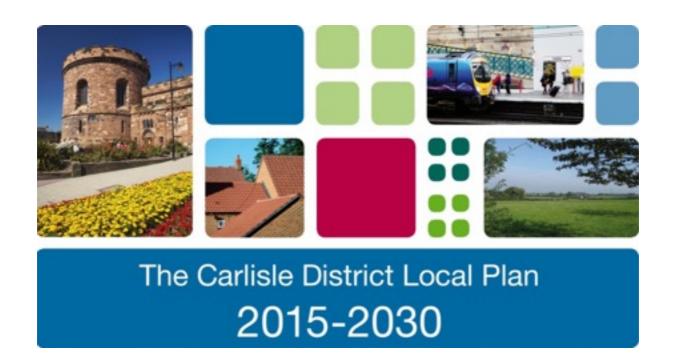
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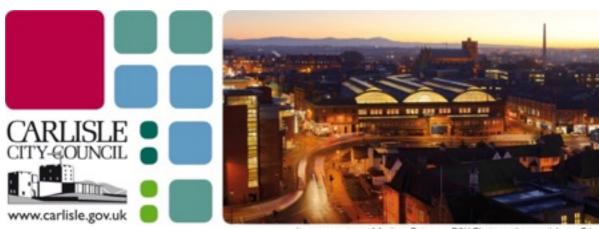

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In respect of this, a site is available which is well related to the ongoing development at Morton and also benefits from being within walking stance to retail, employment (Pirelli's), regular public transport into the City and education facilities. In these respects the site is fully compliant with the three aspects of sustainability promoted throughout the National Planning Policy Framework.
