

The site subject of this objection, land at Durdar Farm, Strategic Land Availability
Assessment Site Reference DU03, is, in the SHLAA, identified as having potential
n the Carlisle South urban expansion. ie. post 2025.
The Site Assessment stating that "This is a partly brownfield and is large for a
settlement the size of Durdar. Durdar has little in the way of services, but it lies
close to both Carlisle and Dalston and therefore the argument can be made that it
vould be a sustainable location. This site could have long term potential as part o
masterplan for Carlisle South urban expansion."

It is noted that the Local Planning Authority have accepted that the development of the site on a whole for residential development is appropriate in the longer term this position is welcomed.

An objection is, however, raised as the land/property at the steading itself and in it's immediate vicinity are wholly appropriate for residential development in the short term. A residential development on this part of the site can be carried out in a manner which will not prejudice the delivery of the larger scale development of the land as a whole in the longer term.

In the context of the preceeding, it is considered that the positive attributes set out above, support the property at the Farm steading and its vicinity for allocation in the forthcoming Carlisle District Local Plan of land for residential development.
