The site extends into open countryside, resulting in any development being seen as an unwarranted and unnecessary intrusion into the landscape.

The greenfield site consists of high quality Grade 2 agricultural land which is actively farmed and makes a useful contribution to food security and the rural economy.

The site was rejected in the Local Plan consultation last Spring, resulting in most residents being currently unaware of this latest proposal.

The development of this site would have an adverse impact on the amenities of the properties along Hill Head and Scotby Road and on the residents' enjoyment of their homes and quality of life. The inclusion of land behind Holme Close was rejected on amenity grounds and for consistency, so should the Hill Head site.

There is a potential drainage problem on this site, as identified by United Utilities and the Environment Agency. There are known flooding problems along Scotby Road due to the lack of capacity in the foul/surface water sewers.

Scotby has already accommodated around 40 new homes on one site alone in the last year.

Development of this site would undermine the Council's policy of trying to encourage urban regeneration in Carlisle,in particular in bringing forward underused and derelict sites and in encouraging re-investment in the older housing neighbourhoods.
