CUMBERLAND COUNCIL PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER 2026 – GATING BETWEEN CHAPEL STREET TO MAIN STREET, EGREMONT (No.1)2026

Cumberland Council ("The Council") in exercise of the power under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (the Act) and being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 59 the Act have been met, makes the following Order:

1. The Order relates to the alley running between Chapel Street to Main Street, Egremont, Cumbria as shown on the plan below in Schedule 1. (Restricted Area)
2. This Order may be cited as CUMBERLAND COUNCIL Chapel Street to Main Street Egremont Public Spaces Protection Order (No.1) 2026 and shall come into force on the 10 February 2026 for the duration of three years. 3. This Council is satisfied that the two conditions below have been met in that:
 - a. Activities carried out in and around the Restricted Area have had a detrimental effect on the quality of life to those in the locality, and it is likely that these activities will recur in the Restricted Area and that they will have such an effect if the Order is not made.
 - b. That the effect, or likely effect of the activities described above, is, or is likely to be, of a persistent or continuing nature, is, or is likely to be, such as to make the activities unreasonable, and justifies the restrictions imposed by this Order.

The Council is satisfied that the conditions set out in Sections 59 have been met and that the requirements of sections 64 and 72 of the Act have been complied with, and that it is, in all the circumstances, expedient to make this order.

The said activities include anti-social behaviour and criminal damage likely to cause harassment, alarm and distress.

4. The effect of the Order is to impose the following conditions on the use of the Restricted Area:
 - a. To prohibit the public right of way at all times over the Restricted Area which runs between Chapel Street and Main Street Egremont, as indicated on the plan, by all persons except for: -
 - Owners/leaseholders of premises adjacent to or adjoining the Restricted Area affected by this Order and who have been provided with a key/code by the Council.
 - Fire Brigade, Police or NHS Trust/Foundation staff when in exercise of their duties.
 - Employees, contractors or agents of statutory undertakers in relation to gas, electricity or water or telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1994 situated in the relevant highway in connection with the laying, erecting, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any relevant apparatus.
 - Council staff and authorised contractors when in the exercise of their duties.
 - Persons using the highway with the permission of or on the direction of a duly authorised Council Officer in this regard.
 - b. The Order authorises the installation and maintenance of gates which will enforce the access restriction.
 - c. An alternative route available for pedestrian access is via Chapel Street, which is marked on the plan in Schedule 1.

5. Any person, other than those persons listed in Paragraph 4 above, is guilty of an offence under section 67 of the Act if they breach the restrictions of this Public Spaces Protection Order by entering the area referred to above. A person guilty of an offence under section 67 of the Act is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale. A constable or an authorised person may issue a fixed penalty notice to anyone he or she has reason to believe has committed an offence under section 67 of the Act in relation to a Public Spaces Protection Order by entering the area referred to above.

6. If any interested person desires to question the validity of this Order on the grounds that the Council had no power to make it or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with in relation to this Order, he or she may apply to the High Court within 6 weeks from the date on which this Order is made.

This Order shall remain in force until 9 February 2029.

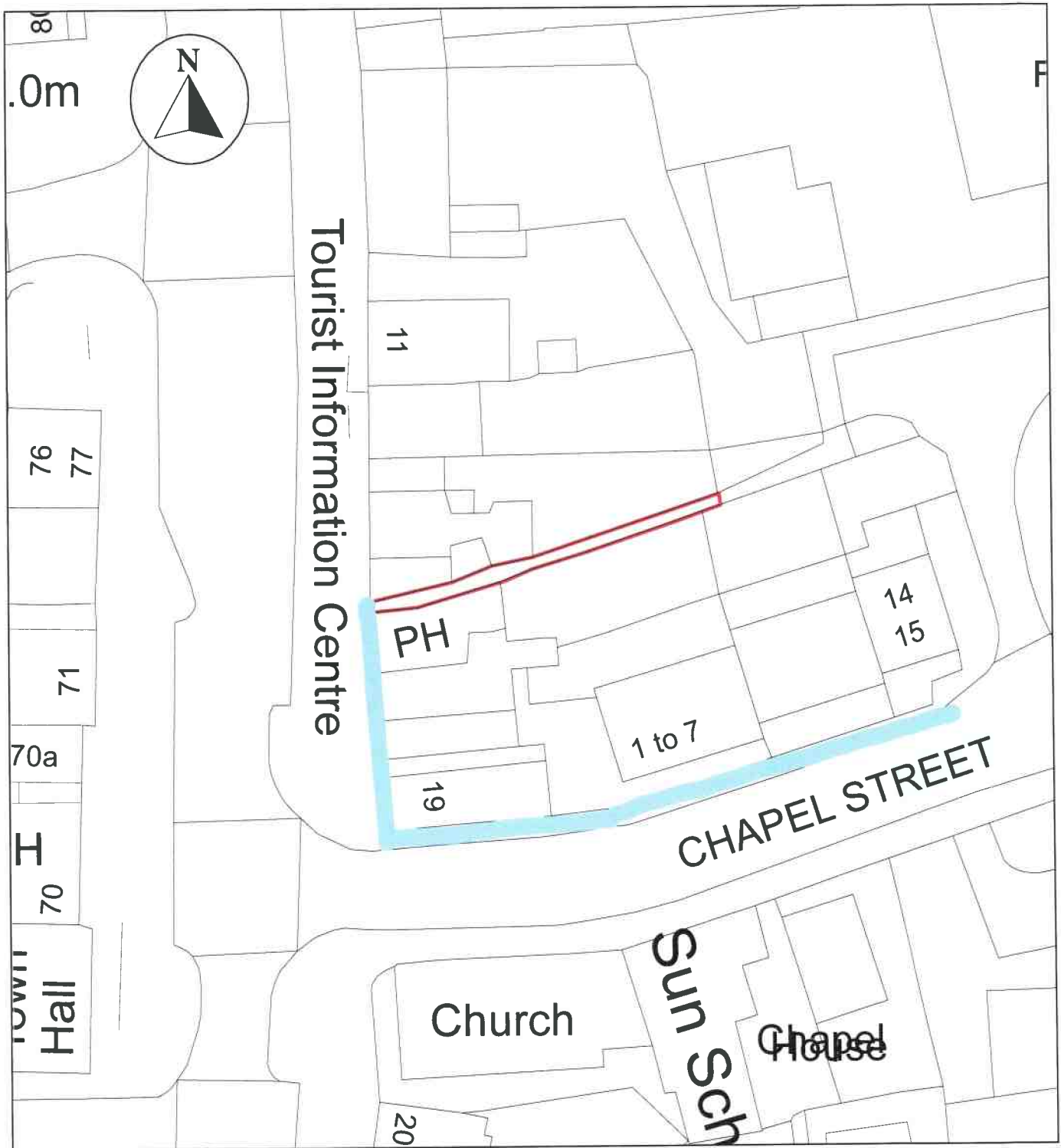
