

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, ASPATRIA, SILLOTH, WIGTON AND SURROUNDING AREAS) (CONSOLIDATION AND PROVISION OF TRAFFIC REGULATIONS)  
ORDER 2024

1. Cumberland Council hereby give notice that it proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 19, 32, 35, 35A, 38, 45, 46, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 64 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
2. The effect of the above Order will be to consolidate, re-enact and revoke the “Cumberland Council (Various Roads, Aspatria, Silloth, Wigton and Surrounding Areas) (Consolidation and Provision of Traffic Regulations) Order 2024, and introduce the following additional proposed restrictions: -
  - a) “No Waiting At Any Time Restrictions” (double yellow lines) on parts of the following: -
    - i) George Street, William Street, Proctors Square, Market Hill and South End, Wigton;
    - ii) West Street, Queen Street, St Mungo’s Park and Lawson Street, Aspatria;
    - iii) Esk Street, Skiddaw Street, Eden Street/B5302, Silloth; and
    - iv) Main Street, Abbeytown.
  - b) “Disc Parking, Waiting Limited to 1 hour, Return Prohibited within 1 hour, 8.00 am – 6.00 pm, Mon – Sat inclusive (Resident Permit Holders Exempt), on part Market Hill, Wigton;
  - c) “Disc Parking, Waiting Limited to 2 hours, Return Prohibited within 2 hours, 8.30 am – 6.00 pm, Mon – Sat inclusive” on part of West Street, Aspatria;
  - d) “No Loading/Unloading, At Any Time” on part of Queen Street, Aspatria;
  - e) “7.5 Tonnes Weight Restriction, Except for Access” on the following: -
    - i) C2046 and C2010 Blencogo;
    - ii) U2004 Easton;
    - iii) C2021 Aughertree;
    - iv) U2103 Torpenhow; and
    - v) U2029 and U2030 Causewayhead
  - f) “Disabled Badge Holders Parking Places, 8.30 am – 6.00 pm Mon – Sat inclusive, Waiting Limited to 3 Hours, Return Prohibited within 3 Hours” on part of Criffel Street, Silloth
  - g) “One-Way Traffic” on Skiddaw Street and Esk Street, Silloth, between the junctions with Raglan Court and Solway Street only; and
  - h) “No Stopping on ‘School Keep Clear’ Markings” on parts of the C2002 Westnewton; and King Street, Wigton.
