This could include ideas to improve local facilities, high streets, green spaces, community safety, youth provision, transport links, pride in the local area, or anything else residents say matters most.

As a Board member, you will be involved in:

- speaking to local residents, groups, businesses and community organisations
- helping identify the biggest opportunities and challenges in your area
- supporting the development of a local Neighbourhood Plan
- reviewing funding proposals
- making sure projects reflect what local people want and need
- championing your community and helping keep residents informed

We want boards to reflect the communities they serve, so we are keen to hear from people of all ages and backgrounds, including residents, volunteers, faith leaders, youth workers, business owners, community organisers, parents, carers and people involved in local clubs, groups or charities.

The most important thing is that you are passionate about your community and willing to work constructively with others to make it stronger.
