

**CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, COCKERMOUTH AND SURROUNDING AREA)
(MOVING TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 20><**

Cumberland Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 19, 64, 122 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 after consultation with the Chief Constable of Cumbria in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

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PART I

GENERAL

1. This Order shall come into operation on xxxx and may be cited as Cumberland Council (Various Roads, Cockermouth and Surrounding Area) (Moving Traffic Restrictions) Order 20><

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them: -

“2000 Regulations” means the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 (SI 2000 No. 683);

“Ambulance” means a vehicle which—

- (a) is constructed or adapted for, and used for no other purpose than, the carriage of sick, injured or disabled people to or from welfare centres or places where medical or dental treatment is given; and
- (b) is readily identifiable as a vehicle used for the carriage of such people by being marked ‘Ambulance’ on both sides.

“Authorised Vehicle” means a passenger vehicle or a goods carrying vehicle the overall height of which does not exceed 2.28 metres.

“Civil Enforcement Officer” shall mean the person or persons duly authorised in writing in that behalf (from time to time) by the Council;

“Disabled Person” means a person who holds a disabled persons' badge in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (No. 682) or any re-enactment thereto;

“Disabled Person's Badge” means a badge issued in accordance with the provisions of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended) (in particular Regulation 11 and the Schedule thereto) or under regulations having effect in Scotland and Wales under Section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 as referred to currently by the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled) (England) Regulations 2000 (No. 683) or any subsequent further re-enactments thereof;

“Driver”, means the person driving the Vehicle;

“Goods” includes goods or burden of any description;

“Goods Vehicle” means a Motor Vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of Goods or burden of any description or a Trailer so constructed or adapted;

“Taxi” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

“Heavy Commercial Vehicle” has the same meaning as in section 138 of the 1984 Act and which has an operating Weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes;

“Junction” means, unless otherwise indicated in this Order, the intersection of the general alignment of the carriageway edges of two roads;

“Local Authority” means, for the purpose of this Order, Cumberland Council as Traffic Authority;

“Maximum Gross Weight” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

“Map Schedule” means the Map Schedule being a collection of Map Tiles listed and inserted into Schedule 1, which depicts the traffic movement prohibitions and

restrictions designated by this Order, and in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend, identifies the type of each particular prohibition and restriction and, if appropriate, certain of its governing provisions:

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the Map Schedule and where a traffic movement prohibition or restriction is depicted on the Map Schedule, that prohibition or restriction will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data;

“Map Schedule Legend” means the Map Schedule Legend to this Order which, when used in conjunction with a Map Tile as listed and included in Schedule 1, identifies the specific type of traffic movement prohibition or restriction designated by this Order and, where appropriate, certain of their governing provisions;

“Map Tile” means an individual Map Tile with a specific reference, being part of the Map Schedule as listed and included in Schedule 1;

“Map Tile Label” where shown on a Map Tile forming part of the Map Schedule in relation to a traffic movement prohibition or restriction, means a label which indicates the type of prohibition or restriction and, if appropriate, certain of its governing provisions;

“Owner”, in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used;

“Pedal cycle” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

“Post Office” and any reference to “Post Office Vehicle” or “Postal Packets” shall be construed in the context of the Postal Services Act 2000 and the Consequential Amendments Order 2001 (No. 2001/648);

“Prescribed Hours” means those hours and on those days during which are on the map labels;

“Road” means any length of highway or any other road to which the public has access, and includes any bridge over which a road passes;

“Traffic Sign” means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under, Section 64 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended);

“Vehicle” means a Motor Vehicle or a Trailer and “Motor Vehicle” and “Trailer” have the same meaning as in section 136 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and includes any part of a Vehicle;

“Weight” in relation to a Vehicle means the gross Weight of that Vehicle together with its load (if any).

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- (3) The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

PART II
PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Prohibition of Vehicles

3. Save as provided in Article 4 or as specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, no person shall cause a Vehicle (or specified class of Vehicle) at any time or on any day or days or during any time period or period, as specified in the Map Schedule, to enter or proceed in any location in any Road or part of Road indicated as being prohibited to such traffic by Traffic Signs and is identified as such in the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle to proceed in the lengths of Road or sides of Road referred indicated on the Map Tile, if the Vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or to avoid an accident;
 - (b) a Vehicle used for police, fire brigade or Ambulance purposes, or a Vehicle (other than a passenger Vehicle) in the service of a Local Authority or water authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (d) being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Roads or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said Roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (e) for or in connection with mechanical Road cleansing or mechanical refuse collection;
 - (f) to cause a Vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by Traffic Signs placed pursuant to Sections 66 and 67 of the RTRA 1984.

Prohibition of Vehicles – Except for Access

5. Save as provided in Article 6 or as specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit a Vehicle (or specified class of Vehicle), except for access, at any time or on any day or days or during any time period or period, as specified in the Map Schedule, to enter or proceed in any location in any Road or part of Road indicated as being prohibited to such traffic by Traffic Signs and is identified as such in the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend.
6. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle to proceed in the lengths of Road or sides of Road referred indicated on the Map Tile, if the Vehicle is being used:-
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, Goods or burden to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those lengths of Road;
 - (b) in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or to avoid an accident;
 - (c) a Vehicle used for police, fire brigade or Ambulance purposes, or a Vehicle (other than a passenger Vehicle) in the service of a Local Authority or water authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- (d) to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (e) being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Roads or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said Roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (f) for or in connection with mechanical Road cleansing or mechanical refuse collection;
- (g) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the lengths of Road indicated on the Map Tile and by Traffic Signs placed on the Road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled on that land;
- (h) to cause a Vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by Traffic Signs placed pursuant to Sections 66 and 67 of the RTRA 1984.

PART III

ONE-WAY TRAFFIC

- 7. No person shall cause or permit a Pedal Cycle or a Vehicle to proceed other than in the prescribed direction in any Road or part of Road being a One Way Road indicated by a Traffic Sign and is identified as such within the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend.
- 8. Nothing in Article 7 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Pedal Cycle or Vehicle to proceed in the lengths of Road or sides of Road referred indicated on the Map Tile, if the Vehicle is being used in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.

PART IV

WIDTH RESTRICTIONS

- 9. Save as provided in Article 10 or as specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any Vehicle with an overall width of which, inclusive of any load (if any) carried on the Vehicle, exceeds the stated maximum width restriction, to proceed in any of the Roads or parts of Roads indicated as being width restricted, by a Traffic Sign at the location of the maximum width restriction and identified as such in the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend.
- 10. Nothing in Article 9 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle exceeding the maximum width restriction stated on the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend, to proceed in the lengths of Road or sides of Road referred indicated on the Map Tile, if the Vehicle is being used: -
 - (a) for the conveyance of persons, Goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of Road indicated on the Map Tile and by Traffic Signs placed on the Road;
 - (b) for the purposes of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the lengths of Road indicated on the Map Tile and by Traffic Signs placed on the Road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon that land;
 - (c) in connection with any building operation or demolition in or adjacent to that length of Road, the removal of any obstruction to traffic in that length of Road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of Road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of Road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or

apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.

- (d) In relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or to avoid an accident;
- (e) a Vehicle used for police, fire brigade or Ambulance purposes, or a Vehicle (other than a passenger Vehicle) in the service of a Local Authority or water authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (f) to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (g) to cause a Vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by Traffic Signs placed pursuant to Sections 66 and 67 of the RTRA 1984.

PART V

LENGTH RESTRICTIONS

- 11. Save as provided in Article 12 or as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order, no person shall cause or permit any Vehicle with an overall length which exceeds the stated maximum length restriction, to proceed in any of the Roads or parts of Roads indicated as being length restricted, by a Traffic Sign at the location of the maximum length restriction and identified as such in the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend.
- 12. Nothing in Article 11 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle exceeding the maximum length restriction stated on the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend, to proceed in the lengths of Road or sides of Road referred indicated on the Map Tile, if the Vehicle is being used: -
 - (a) is being used in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to that length of Road indicated on the Map Tile and by Traffic Signs placed on the Road, of any of the following operations, namely: -
 - (i) the removal of obstructions to traffic;
 - (ii) for, or in connection with, mechanical Road cleansing or mechanical refuse collection;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of Roads;
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, that length of Road of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984.
 - (b) is being used for Fire Brigade, Police or Ambulance purposes;
 - (c) is being used in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on, or adjacent to, the length of Road specified therein, the service of a Local Authority or water or sewerage undertaker which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) is being used in connection with the delivery or collection of Goods or persons at any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of Road indicated on the Map Tile and by Traffic Signs placed on the Road; or

- (e) is being used for the purpose of gaining access for garaging or mechanical servicing at any premises owned by the Vehicle Owner situated on or adjacent to that length of Road indicated on the Map Tile and by Traffic Signs placed on the Road.
- (f) in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or to avoid an accident;
- (g) to cause a Vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by Traffic Signs placed pursuant to Sections 66 and 67 of the RTRA 1984.

PART VI

WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS

13. Except as provided in Article 14 or as specified in Schedule 2 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any Vehicle, with a Maximum Gross Weight in excess of the stated maximum Weight restriction, to proceed in any of the Roads or parts of Roads indicated as being Weight restricted, by a Traffic Sign at the location of the Weight restriction as identified as such within the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend.
14. Nothing in Article 13 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any Vehicle exceeding the maximum Weight restriction of 7.5 tonnes as stated on the Map Schedule in conjunction with the Map Tile Label and/or Map Schedule Legend, to proceed in the lengths of Road or sides of Road referred indicated on the Map Tile, if the Vehicle is: -
 - (a) a Vehicle used for police, fire brigade or Ambulance purposes, or a Vehicle (other than a passenger Vehicle) in the service of a Local Authority or water authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (b) being used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the Road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said Road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (d) being used in connection with the delivery or collection of Goods at any premises situated on or adjacent to that length of Road indicated on the Map Tile and by Traffic Signs placed on the Road;
 - (e) being used for the purpose of gaining access for garaging or mechanical servicing at any premises owned by the Vehicle Owner situated on or adjacent to that length of Road indicated on the Map Tile and by Traffic Signs placed on the Road;
 - (f) being used in relation to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or to avoid an accident;
 - (g) being used for the purpose of gaining access to the B5292 from Hundith Hill crossroads to the summit of Whinlatter Pass;
 - (h) being used for the purpose of gaining access to the B5289 from its junction with the B5292 to Buttermere;
 - (i) proceeding in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by Traffic Signs placed pursuant to Sections 66 and 67 of the RTRA 1984.

PART VII
REVOCATIONS

15. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Orders specified in Schedule 3 to this Order are hereby revoked in part as specified.
